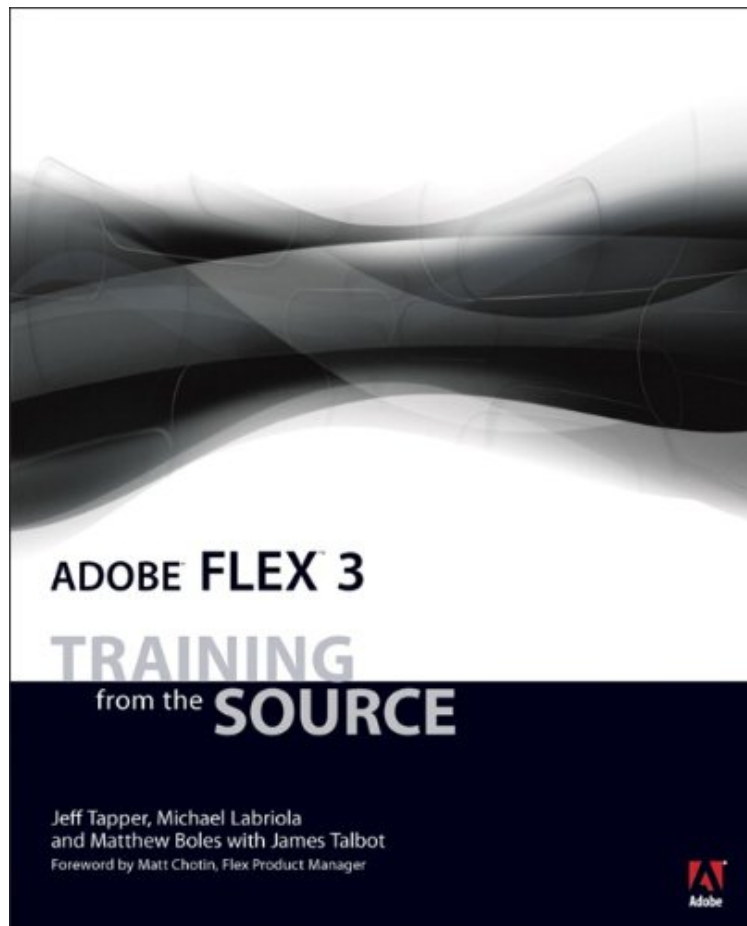

Der Titel "Training from the source" suggeriert natürlich, dass es um viele Beispiele gehen würde, aber dennoch empfand ich sie stellenweise als zu langatmig. Ich habe das Buch noch nicht vollständig durchgearbeitet, war aber von CopyPaste mancher Erklärungen zu Beispielen und dem ständigen Wiederholen des Codes enttäuscht. Man hätte lieber ein Listing mit Zeilennummern drucken sollen und dann die Zeilen erklären, als die vorhergehenden Codezeilen oft zu wiederholen. So was ist unübersichtlich (Was hat sich geändert) und schafft künstlich Buchvolumen. Das Buch ist auch zu stark auf ColdFusion ausgerichtet. Gerade bei komplexen Themen wie der Kommunikation mit einem Server fehlt es an Übersichtlichkeit (HttpService,

WebService, RemoteObject) und etwas mehr Theorie/Einfuehrung.
