As a devout life-long Christian, married to the son of a minister for three decades, she has worked intensively with troubled adolescents

and has supported her husband's committed work with the needy and the homeless. Kristie is the mother of four adult children and five grandchildren. Her primary core values include the importance of love and of hope. As a former teacher of English, I appreciated the imagery and parable in this ebook series about Petal Flower and the life lessons that she experiences. Based on Christian themes, the stories cause the child reader thoughtfully to consider the challenges that Petal faces through her adventures. There is a Biblical reference in each book and a brief questionnaire for the child at the end. The child reader must engage in thinking about the options and lessons in Petal's evolving story, in considering what he/she would do in Petal's circumstances, and in recognizing and dealing with feelings and values. Petal, her sister, her friend Chippy, the Worry Tree, Valley of the Shadow, poison ivy, and the woodlands (Sunlight Meadows) are all characters in the four books. There is a lovely combination of God, nature, relationships, and emotional development that run through the series. Petal prays every night, learns the Ten Commandments, and encounters various temptations and conflicting feelings. What does God want? What is the right thing to do? Will Petal choose the right path? In the fourth book, Many Are Called ~ Few Are Chosen, Petal becomes born again, learns the importance of prayer, and experiences the power of forgiveness and love. Petal learns that she is responsible for her decisions, that Jesus saves those who seek Him, and that there is joy and redemption in being born again spiritually. These books are excellent teaching tools for young Christian children. They address the child's mind, heart, and soul as well.
