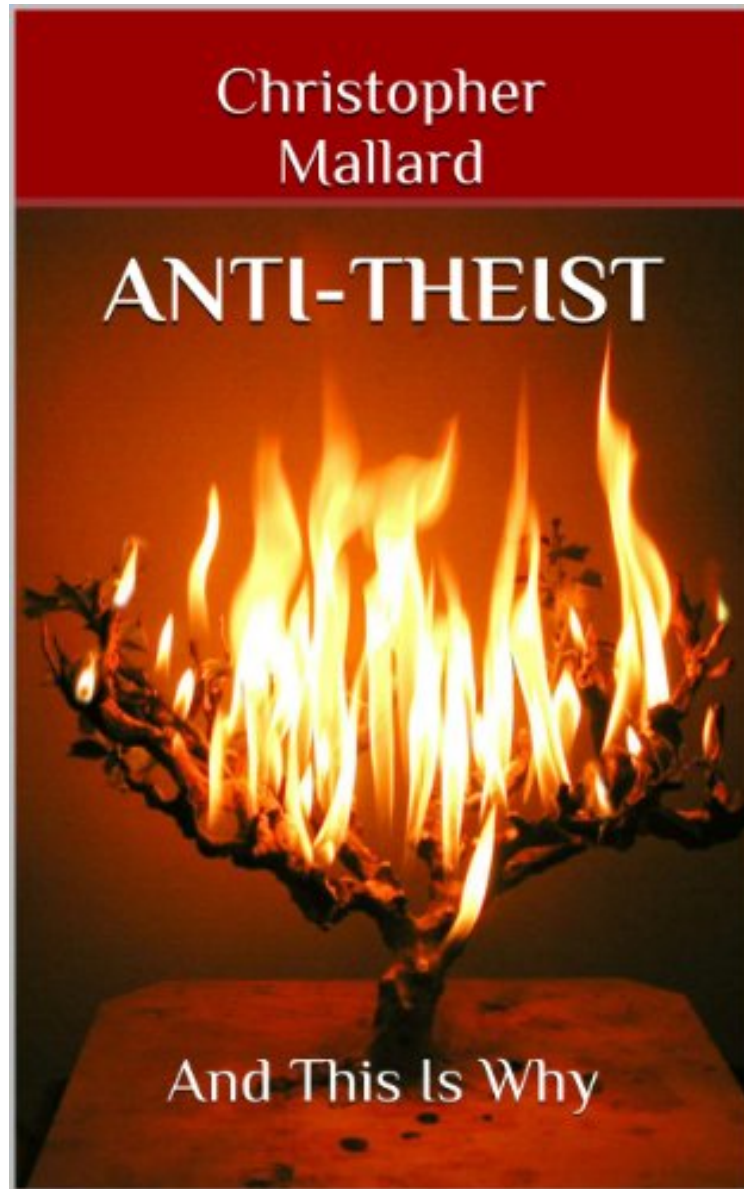

against all the things that religion gets away with these days and a strong argument for atheism or even, as the author calls it, anti-theism (read the book to learn what the difference is). Yes, it is a rant, but as rants go, it is a very well-researched and quite cleverly written one. It is a fun read throughout, with tongue firmly placed in cheek most of the time, but with an extremely serious subject matter. This book explores atheism and, more importantly, the fallacies of religion from a personal point of view, but with many (quite disturbing) quotes from scripture thrown in. It's more personal than Dawkins and less cerebral than Hitchens, but the author conveys his personal feelings very well and that makes it very easy to relate with. I enjoyed reading it from beginning to end and all the more because it was free. Definitely could do with another round of proof-reading though, there are still quite a few typos and misspellings. Let's hope there will be a second/revised edition, that will make it look much more professional. Having said that, I can only thank Mr Mallard from the bottom of my heart for writing all those things down that I'm sure many people feel anyway and backing it all up with research. Definite recommendation!
