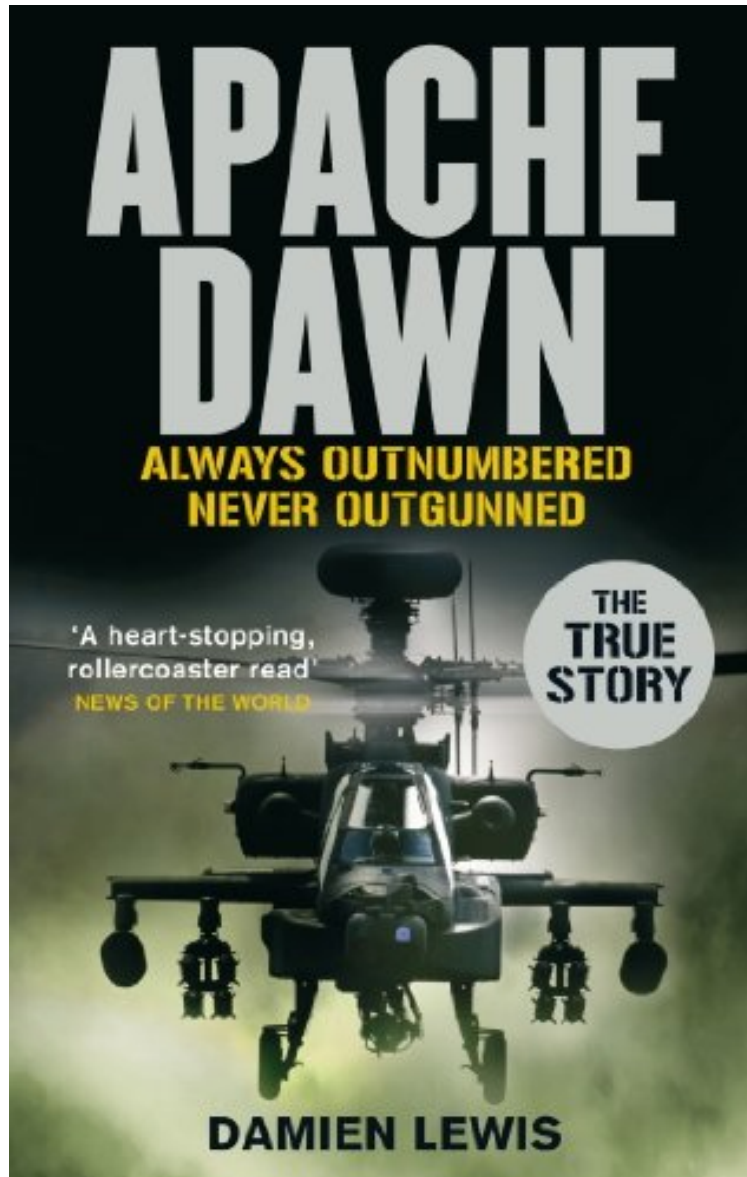

If you are thinking about buying this book, get Ed Macy's instead. What should be a gripping, edge of the seat account of seat of the pants flying just fizzles along, none of the drama and real life terror is conveyed, the pilots just do not come alive and neither does the ground troop's predicament really come across. And while "black" Apaches and B-1Bs may make them sound more menacing, in real life I have yet to see a black one of either of the two.
