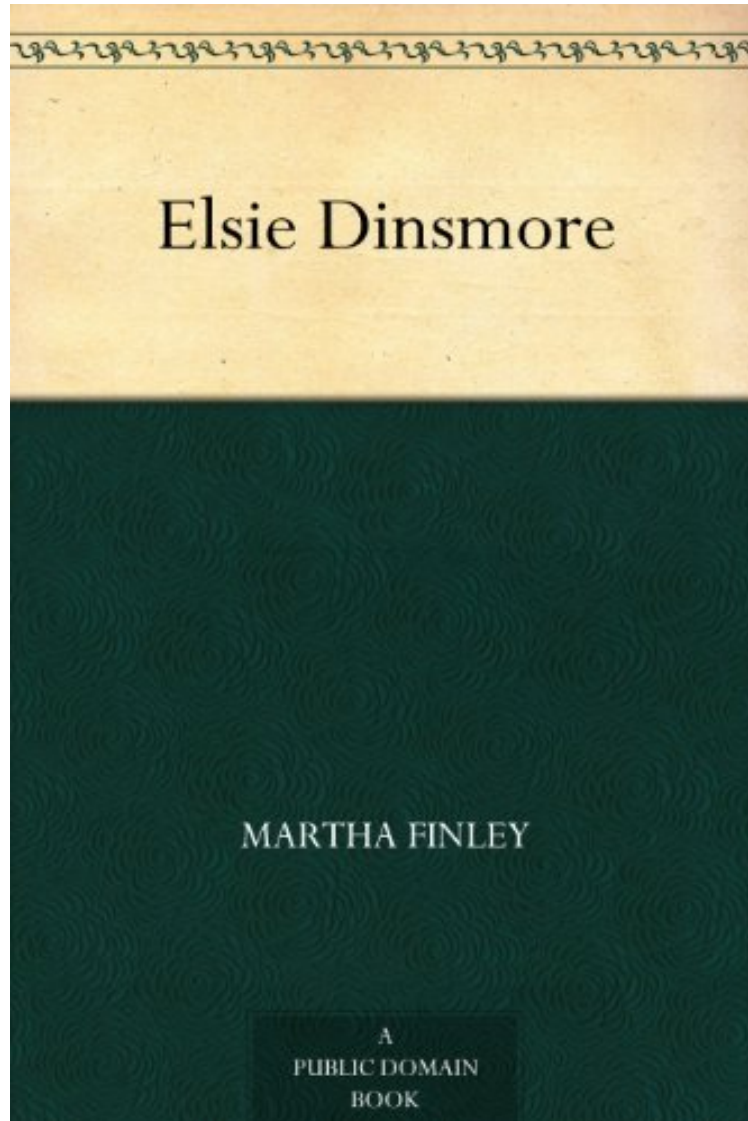

I was, however, delighted to find that .com has most of them. I couldn't believe it when the screen was filled with Elsie titles after I typed "Martha Finley"! I read it twice that year, then again when I was ten, then twice more when I was eleven (the same year I read *Uncle Tom's Cabin* for the first time...another bag of books.) I continued to read Elsie off and on for many years (though I still do not know what happened in the first six pages) and well into adulthood until it fell apart. I put it carefully into a Baggies Zip Lock bag and occasionally take it out for a careful read through.
