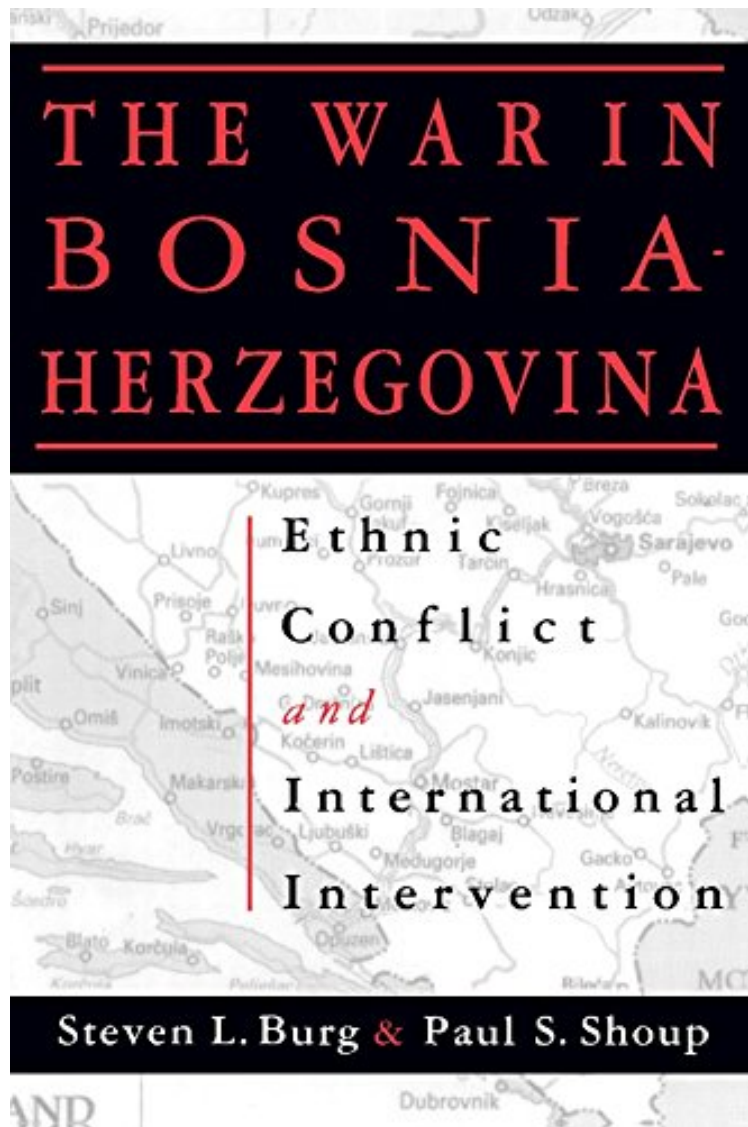

Zunächst möchte ich festhalten, dass dieses Buch tatsächlich alle Facetten abdeckt und tatsächlich viiiieele Informationen liefert. Jeder Aspekt des Krieges wird sehr detailliert beschrieben. So z. B. die Wahlen 1990 und die Strukturen der national ausgerichteten Parteien Bosniens. Was mir jedoch in dieser Fülle von Informationen fehlte war ein klarer roter Faden. Ebenso hatte ich während des Lesens mit dem stellenweise verwirrend anmutenden Schreibstil der Autoren zu kämpfen. Ich muss sagen, dass ich bereits mehrere Bücher zum Thema gelesen habe, die in der Heranführung an die Problematik und in der Ausführung und Darstellung der Ereignisse klarer argumentieren. It is a must read by anyone interested in what happened in that mountainous Balkan country. This book is rather detailed and is not meant to be a 'quick read' for the casual reader. Instead, it uses a vast array of sources from the region as well as the Western press and interviews to make its case about the goals of the three sides as well as the desire of the 'West' to stay out of the conflict. Furthermore, it provides a much-needed and accessible overview of the various peace plans and maps which aimed at stopping the carnage in Bosnia. It is an excellent book which sets a new standard for research on ethnic conflicts and international policy.
